

WHERE TO GET TESTED

Need to get yourself, or your child, tested for COVID-19? Here is a list of local testing spots. Be sure to note if the testing location requires a doctor's order for testing, or if they test children. Most also require an appointment.

Drive-up PCR testing, does not test anyone younger than 12. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. Appointments required, but referrals not required. Every individual who wants a test must make an appointment at MinuteClinic.com. Insurance card and proof of identity are required.
