

COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH GUIDANCE FOR SCHOOLS

Symptom Chart: New, Unexplained Symptoms Either 1 symptom from Row A or 2 from Row B

Row A	Fever of 100.0+	Chills	Cough (not chronic)	Difficulty breathing	Loss of taste/smell	Muscle or body aches
Row B	Sore throat	Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea	Headache	Fatigue	Runny nose	Congestion

Isolation for Positive Cases

Stay home for 10 days after first positive PCR or rapid test sample, or onset of symptoms, whichever occurred first

May return on Day 11 if symptoms mostly resolved and temp <100.0 for 24hrs without fever-reducing medication

7-Day Quarantine if Exposed	10-Day Quarantine if Exposed	14-Day Quarantine if Exposed
Must receive a negative PCR test on Day 5 or later after last exposure to case	If choose not to test	If symptoms emerge per chart, even if negative test already received
Must remain without symptoms per chart	Must remain without symptoms per chart	Advised to PCR test, again if necessary
May return on Day 8	May return on Day 11	May return on Day 15 if symptoms have largely resolved and temp <100.0 F for 24 hrs without fever-reducing medication
Watch for new, unexplained symptoms for 14 days following last exposure	Watch for new, unexplained symptoms for 14 days following last exposure	If test is positive, follow Isolation protocol
